## A Few Things You Should Know

- We are not a conventional Campground; we do not have swimming pools or shuffle board... instead, we have rivers, streams, caves, cliffs and large, private sites with 800+ acres available for recreation. We also have a vast variety of wildlife "capable of eating you as though you're a breakfast snack".
- The use of ATVs is permitted on the property so long as each machine is properly licensed and insured. We require a "Motorized Vehicle Liability Release Form" to be signed and on file before ATVs are downloaded.
- Mufflers must be within manufacturer's specification and excessive noise will not be tolerated. The speed limit is 10 MPH; late-night and "rowdy riding" is not allowed. Common sense and consideration for others is expected.
- Collecting wood for campfires is permitted, however, there may be times when "burning bans" may be in effect by the local governments, and must be complied with.
- Hunting on the property is by membership only and during prime hunting periods, ATV use by campers must be excluded on Saturdays in certain areas.

Our campgrounds are tastefully nestled into breathtaking natural settings and were situated to take maximum advantage of the surrounding topography. Each campsite is unique and must be considered on its own merit. A few considerations might be the size of your rig, your preferences for specific views, your desire for seclusion, proximity to Pine Hill Run trout stream and the various Trail Heads.

## Phase 1 ~ Cliffside

Cliffside consists of 10 beautiful sites, accessed directly off of Seneca Hemlock Road. Cliffside, as it suggests, is the highest of the three facilities, looking down into Pine Hill Run Valley.

## Phase 2 ~ Pine Hill Run

Pine Hill Run consists of 16 spectacular sites which are larger on average, offering a nice mix between solitude and the privacy of this off-road location.

This facility is situated on about 5 Acres, positioned between a vertical Rock Cliff and Pine Hill Run trout stream. This facility is accessed off of Seneca Hemlock Road by turning west onto Misty Ridge Trail and then proceeding about 1/8 of a mile... the facility will be on your left.

## Pricing

We're open all year for various outdoor activities and our road system is well-maintained. Although our goal is to lease each campsite on an annual basis, we are, however, open to any lease arrangement that may be desired. You'll find our pricing to be **VERY** attractive.

## Phase 3 ~ Twin Chimneys

Twin Chimneys consists of 16 spectacular sites which are also larger on average. It's similar to Pine Hill Run in that its proximity to the trout stream is about the same. The topography here offers a bit more slope and a wider variety of views.

## Directions

Take **Interstate 80** to **Exit #29** ( 29 miles east of Ohio state line ) then go **north on Route 8** for exactly 5 miles to **Route 308**. Continue **southbound on Route 308** for exactly 2.4 miles, then **turn left at the Kennerdell Road** (there's no road sign) toward the Village of Kennerdell. Stay on the Kennerdell Road and set your "trip meter". In exactly 4.5 miles you will **cross-over the Allegheny River**. Stay on the Kennerdell Road and continue up the hill on the **east side of the Allegheny for an additional 2.5 miles...** past the Kennerdell Over-Look, to the Seneca Hemlock Road... **your trip meter will be at 7.0 miles. Turn left onto the Seneca Hemlock Road.** Proceed north on Seneca Hemlock Road for approximately 1 mile and Kamp Kennerdell "Cliffside" will be on your left. To access "Pine Hill Run" and "Twin Chimneys" phases, continue north on the Seneca Hemlock Road for an additional 1/4 mile and turn left at Misty Ridge Trail... the campgrounds will be to your left.
